MHS: WILL TAKE PLACE ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 18TH. THE ORCHESTRA DIRECTOR WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SALE OF REFRESHMENTS ETC. AT THIS CONCERT.

DUE TO SOME BUDGET ISSUES FOR THE 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR THAT MATT HAD TO RESOLVE WITH THE ADMINISTRATION, IT WAS AGREED THAT FOR THIS YEAR THE BAND PARENTS ORGANIZATION WOULD COVER THE STIPENDS OF THE 2 COLOR GUARD COACHES AND 1 PERCUSSION COACH. \$1,400 AND \$1250 RESPECTIVELY.

THE ORGANIZATION'S BANK WILL BE USED TO PAY FOR THE MUSIC LICENSING EXPENSES. THERE ARE 4 EXPENSES IN TOTAL FOR THE UPCOMING PERCUSSION AND COLOR GUARD COMPETITIVE SEASON. 2 ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS WILL BE ISSUED: \$255 AND \$380 AND A CHECK WILL BE MAILED FOR AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE OF \$450. MATT WILL INFORM THE EXECUTIVE BOARD OF THE FINAL AMOUNT DUE.
