- Available cash = \$8,640.70
- We are over budget on Gillette and still have 8 events that haven't been paid
- Fall marching band & guard came in under budget
- Patty confirmed that we have a good chance of getting a credit card from Sharon Credit Union. **She will continue to work on this.**
