

Band Camp 2020
Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

The following students are invited to come to band camp on Tuesday August 18th:

- Color Guard
- Front Ensemble (stationary percussion)

The following students are invited to come to band camp on Wednesday August 19th:

- All Woodwind Students

The following students are invited to come to band camp on Thursday August 20th:

- Drumline
- All Brass Students

What to Bring:

- Mask
- Instrument/equipment
- Water (water will not be provided)
- Comfortable sneakers (no open toed shoes)
- Athletic shorts or pants (no jeans)
- A hat
- Bug spray (optional)
- Sun block
- A snack (we will not have a dinner break but students may want a snack if they get hungry)
- Pocket hand sanitizer (optional, there will be bottles available at stations)

Prior to Coming:

- Students should fill out the band camp RSVP and health/emergency contact form
- Students should wash/sanitize their hands prior to leaving for rehearsal

Drop Off:

- Please be sure that all students are free of symptoms and healthy prior to coming to band camp
- Students should come prepared with a mask
- Students should be dropped off in the senior lot. Students who need equipment inside the building will be allowed a few students at a time to get the equipment. Everyone else will be directed to their rehearsal area
- Students should not congregate upon arrival. Please respect social distancing guidelines and have your mask on before you get out of the car.

At Rehearsal:

- Students should follow social distancing guidelines.
- Students should keep their masks on unless directed to take it off by a staff member (due to the physical activity or playing an instrument)
- If a student needs a mask break they should excuse themselves from the group and take their mask break at a safe distance from others
- Students should not congregate during breaks
- If a student starts to feel ill they should notify a staff member immediately. In the event that students become ill, they will call home and leave rehearsal.
- Students using school equipment will be assigned equipment to use. They will use the same equipment all week. Whenever possible please take equipment home to avoid unnecessary trips into the building.
- Students will have access to the portable restrooms at the turf field. Students will not be permitted to enter the building to use the restroom unless absolutely necessary.

Dismissal:

- Once dismissed, students will be allowed into the building in small groups if necessary to return equipment.
- Any student who does not need to enter the school building will return to their cars and go home.
- Students are not permitted to congregate at the end of rehearsal.
- Clean up all of your belongings and trash
- Students should be clear of MHS by 8:30pm. Students will be dismissed from rehearsal promptly at 8pm.
